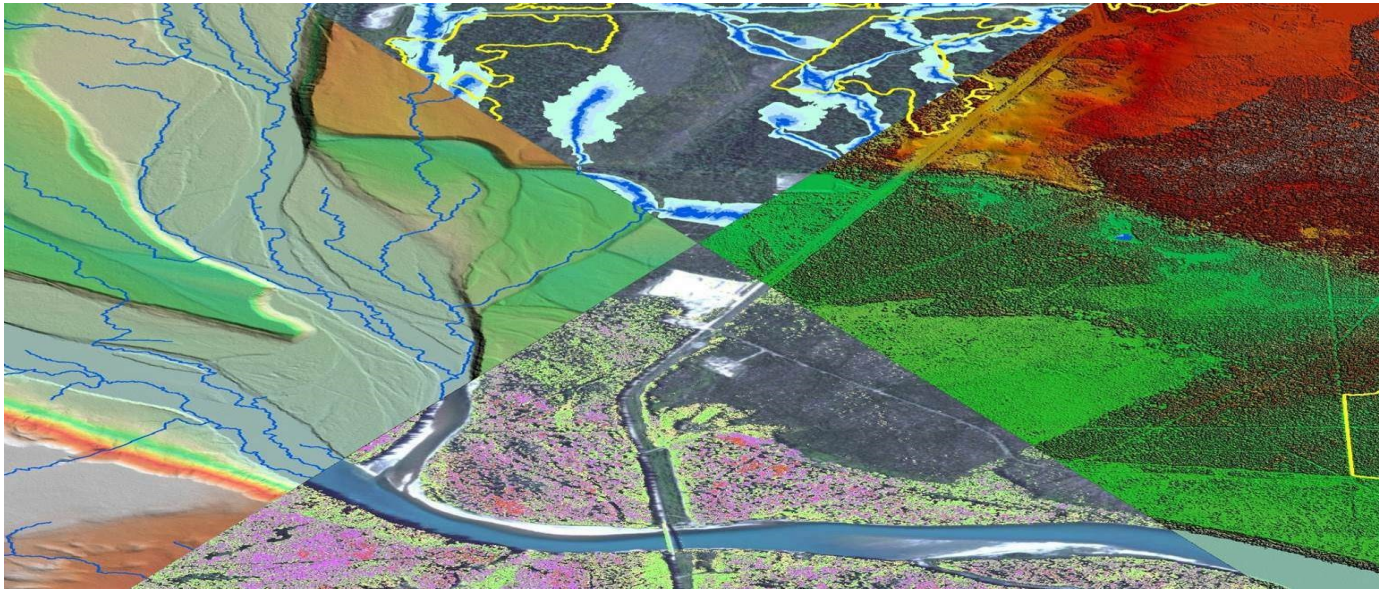

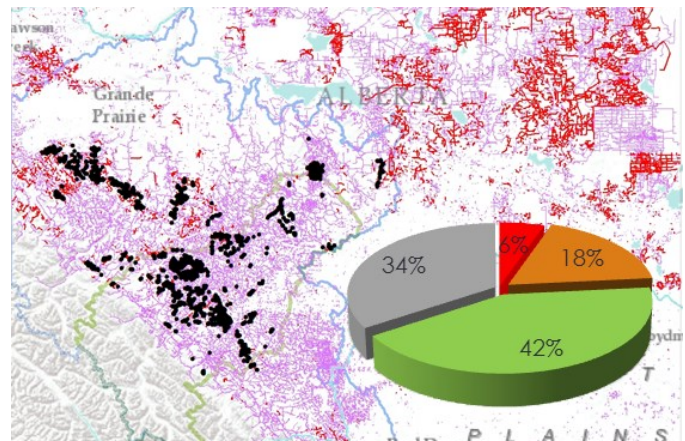


SCARI Decision Support Systems (SCARI — DSS)

MORE INFORMED DECISIONS

The Stream Crossing and Aquatic Resource Inventory (SCARI-DSS) was created to protect and preserve water resources. The DSS provides data regarding fish passage concerns, structural safety of bridges and culverts, and sedimentation levels. These data enable us to subsequently classify crossings based on risk ranking.

Woodlands North has implemented processes which integrate spatial analysis, field data sensors, and mobile applications. The resulting database is connected with the Decision Support System which provides critical information based on stringent criteria.
